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New SCORE® and CitySmart® Programs from TNMP

Late last month, TNMP launched its 2014 commercial energy efficiency programs with a raffle and a webinar describing important changes to the SCORE, CitySmart and Commercial Solutions programs. We're excited to report that more than 50 commercial customers, contractors and service providers attended, including Mr. Don Cook of Trane Commercial Systems and Mr. Joel Hannemann of Friendswood ISD, the winners of our raffle!

In case you missed the webinar, here are a few important changes to note:

- SCORE and CitySmart both updated their incentive rates. Participants
 are now eligible to receive \$200/kW (compared to \$194/kW in 2013).
 Additionally, participants can elect to earn \$250/kW by enrolling in SCORE
 Lite or CitySmart Lite programs, which provide a higher incentive rate but
 fewer program services.
- Underserved school districts will receive cash incentives of \$325/kW. We
 will contact these districts directly to let them know that they qualify for a
 higher incentive.
- Hard-wired and screw-in compact fluorescent lights (CFLs) no longer qualify for incentives through the SCORE, CitySmart or Commercial Solutions programs.

The SCORE® Program provides viable energy optimization for school districts, colleges and universities. Designed to educate institutions on energy management and encourage investment in energy efficiency, this program helps partners minimize the impact of volatile energy costs, ease budget pressures, improve infrastructure and optimize learning environments for students.

The CitySmart® Program helps local government entities enhance energy efficiency, lower operating costs, improve air and environmental quality, and meet legislative and regulatory requirements.

Similar to SCORE and CitySmart, the TNMP Commercial Solutions Program provides technical and financial support to help commercial and industrial organizations identify and implement energy efficiency upgrade projects.

The Open Program for small businesses program targets commercial facilities below 100kW in demand usage to enable them to participate in energy saving retrofits.
