
2025 Program Documents and Milestones

Stay on track with key dates and required documentation for the 2025 TNMP Energy Efficiency Program. Use the resources below to ensure timely submissions and full program compliance.

Date	Performance Milestone Date Requirement
September 30, 2025	At least 85% of total committed homes/systems <u>must be invoiced</u> on the Program's online system <u>and</u> the required documentation for the invoiced homes must be uploaded to the online system.
November 30, 2025	100% of total committed homes/systems <u>must be invoiced</u> on the Program's online system <u>and</u> the required documentation for the invoiced homes must be uploaded to the online system.


Are you a homebuilder in West Texas?



Texas Energy Efficiency Learning Center

As a participating contractor, you have FREE access to the Energy Efficiency Learning Center (EELC).

The EELC is an online distance-learning portal



where contractors can login to take trainings on Sales and Marketing, Technical Topics, and Best Practices. Contractors are also able to view recorded webinars, demonstrations, and other program related training materials.

Many courses can also be used to meet Continuing Education Unit (CEU) requirements for common industry certifications, including NATE, RESNET, and BPI. All courses eligible for CEUs have a short exam and require and 80% or higher score to pass. Once you click on Catalog, you can filter courses under the "CEU Accredited" category.
